

#Friend Me

Use privacy settings for social media and apps. Only accept someone you know in person as a social media friend. Only communicate with people that you know in person.

#Selfies

Don't post, share or text photos or videos that show off your body. Only take and let others take photos or videos of you that you are okay with the whole world seeing.

#App Aware

Only use trusted apps with hundreds of good ratings. Turn off location, camera and microphone in device settings for each app.

#That's Personal

Avoid posting personal information like your address or where you are every day. Don't give this information to anyone you met on a screen.

#Stranger Danger

Don't meet someone in person that you met through social media or the internet unless a parent or guardian is involved.

#Yikes!

Use safe search mode when surfing the web. Leave a screen right away and tell a safe adult if you see pornography.

- 2. Create a list of all the social media websites, apps and gaming devices that traffickers or other predators might use to meet kids or teens.
