The Battered Immigrant Project (BIP) is a statewide project of Legal Aid of North Carolina that provides immigration assistance to immigrant victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and human trafficking. We also provide technical assistance and training to advocates and agencies who serve this client population. All immigrant victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and human trafficking (male and female (includes transgender male-to-female and female-to-male), adults and minors, victims of labor and/or sex trafficking) can contact the BIP for an intake screening to see if they meet our income and eligibility requirements for services.
